This message is being sent by the ASCCC Open Educational Resources (OER) Initiative on behalf of a faculty member who is seeking colleagues to collaborate on OER for Oral Interpretation of Literature (C-ID COMM 170). As the OERI requires that funded projects involve collaborators from at least three California Community College districts, we are assisting potential applicants who need collaborators. The need is described as follows:

Oral Interpretation of Literature is a course within communication studies (and some theatre) programs across the country. I would be interested in getting a collaborative group of Interpretation instructors to work on creating an OER for this course. At minimum collaborators should have a Master's Degree in Communication Studies and/or Theatre Arts and be experienced in teaching an Oral Interpretation of Literature course. A desirable qualification would be for collaborators to have experience performing/competing in Interpretation on a forensics team of intramurally.
