The Why



Task Force Charge

- 1. Assess the system's existing infrastructure in place that guides instructional material choice
- 2. Provide recommendations and possible regulatory actions for system structural changes that will facilitate the creation of sustainable solutions that reduce instructional materials costs for students in the long term



Task Force – Key Recommendations

System commitment & local goals

Regulation review to empower student choice, alleviate student burdens, and ensure funding flexibility

Data infrastructure to support continuous improvement

Scale OER and openly licensed materials by strengthening systemwide coordination and PD, enhanced by technology

Expand system-level procurement

Joint advocacy for additional ongoing investment

Provide recommendations to ensure sustainable no-cost textbook solutions for GE courses
