

SURVEYS AIM TO UNDERSTAND THE ROLE OF OER


Goals of Surveys


Open Educational Resources (OER): OER is defined as "teaching, learning, and research resources that reside in the public domain or have been released under an intellectual property license that permits their free use and repurposing by others." Unlike traditionally copyrighted material, these resources are available for "open" use, which means users can edit, modify, customize, and share them.

2023-24 Faculty: Current Teaching Modality (Select All)




Nationally, 2-year schools are much more likely to fully online courses and similar rates of face-to-face; suggests more faculty teach in both modalities.


Courses in higher education are offered fully online or in blended formats and at a higher than pre-pandemic rate.

2023-24 Faculty: Required Textbook Format




Faculty: Required Textbook Format by Year



Digital formats of textbooks are almost as commonly available in Higher Education with year over year decreases in print-only option.

BEYOND THE TEXTBOOK, DIGITAL FORMAT DOMINATES




Majority of faculty use digital formats for non-textbook materials for students, at much higher rates than textbooks

FACULTY OER AWARENESS



OVER HALF OF FACULTY ARE AWARE OF OER






- One third of faculty are unaware of OER, even name recognition
- Remaining faculty are split in their level of awareness
 - 56% are "somewhat" to "very aware" of OER

OER AWARENESS REMAINS ABOVE 50% BUT DID NOT GAIN


- OER awareness has dropped for the first time for our reports to the prior year's level
- 8% decrease from the peak level of awareness during the 2022-23 academic year (64%)
- Change of awareness was seen across all faculty and institutional demographics




OER USE DROPS SLIGHTLY AS WELL

- 41% of faculty respondents report using OER materials as either required or supplemental course materials, or both in at least one course
 - Small decrease from last year
- These OER materials can be any type of resource they aren't limited to textbooks.

FACULTY THOUGHTS ON OER USE

- Faculty are more likely to report using OER in courses with an online component and for introductory course levels
- Faculty sentiment around OER use largely mirrors perspectives on digital versus print with similar numbers reporting material quality as either a positive or negative attribute
 - OER adopters stated that finding materials that meet their needs is cited as a challenge
 - Respondents who haven't adopted OER, or refuse to, primarily listed the lack of quality of OER options as the chief reason for their opposition

"I fully support OER materials. Knowledge should not be kept behind a paywall." - Introductory Linguistics / Languages Faculty

"In my experience, the use of an OER textbook imposes a burden on the teacher since the book does not come with any teaching resources typically provided by commercial textbook publishers. Institutions should find a way to support the production of supplemental resources to faculty who decide to adopt an OER textbook."






2023-24 Faculty: Current Teaching Modality (Select All)

REQUIRED TEXTBOOK FORMAT






CA faculty are slightly more likely to have required textbooks available as digital formats, mostly in an option for both

OER AWARENESS


2023-24 Faculty: OER Awareness



CA faculty are slightly more aware of OER, especially at the highest category


CA OER AWARENESS

OER USE




CA faculty are more likely to use OER as required materials; this is the highest proportion across all states

Does your institution designate or label courses with no cost or zero cost for students?




CA leads the nation in course marking awareness by faculty, with twice as many faculty reporting it is used and much fewer unaware of it in general.

Does your institution designate or label courses in the course catalog that use OER materials for students?



If used, most course markings combine OER and free/zero cost; CA has much higher rates of marking than national

CONCLUSIONS



2023-24 HIGHER EDUCATION OER UPDATES

- Digital formats are commonly offered for textbook and many other student course materials
 - Homework and assessments are 2-3x more likely to not have a physical option than are textbooks
- Faculty OER awareness remains high 1 in 2 faculty are aware – but the level declined for the first time since measurements started in 2015

CALIFORNIA - SAME BUT DIFFERENT?





- General trends in digital use for higher education in California mirror national levels
 - This was not as true a few years ago the other states have caught up to California
- CA faculty are more aware and do use OER more than national level (slightly)
- CA leads the nation in course marking for students, though does not often explicitly differentiate OER from zero cost


